REPAIR – REFURBISH - RENEW

We all know that replacing surfaces and furniture can be costly – for the planet as well as the wallet. But very often, people don't realise how easy it is to repair or refurbish something to breathe new life into it.

Over time, surfaces become worn. This may be due to wear and tear, abrasive cleaners, or a particular accident. You can repair or refurbish any type of hard surface to look good as new including scuffs, burns, scratches, cracks, and dents. Repairs can be easy and quick. Refurbishment is the process of improvement by cleaning, decorating, and re-equipping.

SAVE MONEY

By repairing and refurbishing you can save money, potentially thousands of pounds depending on the project, without loss of quality or aesthetic. Regardless of the reason for refurbishment or repair, you can typically **save up to 85%** of the cost of replacement.

As well as the cost of the original item (e.g. floor or wardrobe) when you replace some items (for example a worktop), you may need to replace other things around it such as fixtures and fittings. In this case you would also be paying for the workman's time to take it out and put a new one in which can be time consuming. Instead, a technician can come and assess the item, then use the most appropriate solution to repair a small piece of damage or refurbish an entire surface at your premises.



SAVE TIME

The time taken to rip out and replace most surfaces can be lengthy making it inconvenient at best and an unforeseen cost at worst. If you are unable to use a room or facility because you are having an element replaced, this will be a pain. Commercially, it may also impact your bottom line if you are unable to use a room or specific facility for a longer period.

Generally speaking, the time taken to repair something will be less than to replace it (though this is project dependent). We have spent just a few hours repairing burns or cracks and not days it would take to replace entire units, worktops or floors).



SAVE THE PLANET

We are all conscious of the damage today's throwaway society is impacting on the earth, but by regenerating surfaces you can reduce your contribution to landfill and look at eco-friendly solutions to help make even greater impact.



Around 10% of UK emissions are associated with the manufacture and transport of construction materials (Source: UK Green Building Council) The UK is committed to reducing carbon emissions by 80% by 2050 (Climate Change Act, 2008) so savings linked to refurbishment will have an important part to play in meeting this target.

Modern paint technology, which is increasingly tending towards environmentally friendly options, is also a bonus when looking at the environmental impact of refurbishing rather than replacing, and it makes sense to talk to your supplier about the processes they are using.

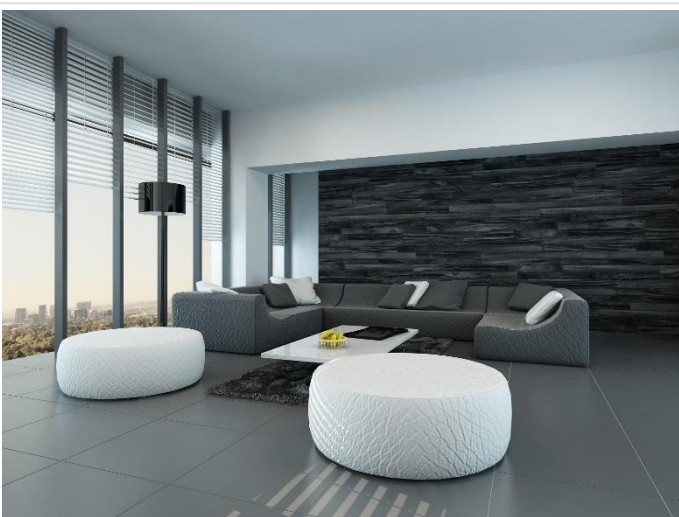
Also, by improving the efficiency of radiators, windows, and doors you can save on emissions due to heating.



What can be refurbished?
